



## CONDITIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CHARITY AUCTION SUPPORTING THE FONDAZIONE RICERCA FIBROSI CISTICA (Italian Foundation for Cystic Fibrosis Research)



The artist Annalù (Annaluigia Boeretto, born in 1976, in San Dona di Piave, Venice) represented by the PUNTO SULL'ARTE gallery in Varese, has put her work *Arborea*, pictured below, up to auction with the intent to donate the proceeds to the Fondazione Ricerca Fibrosi Cistica (herein referred to as "FFC"), the non-profit organization recognized by MIUR (Ministero dell'Istruzione, dell'Università e della Ricerca – Ministry of Education, University and Research). Since 1997, the Fondazione has been actively engaged in scientific research of the serious genetic disorder, Cystic Fibrosis, and for which there is still no definitive cure. This disorder affects 7,000 people in Italy and over 100,000 people around the world.

The agreement foresees that FFC receives the proceeds of the sale of *Arborea* (hereinafter referred to as "Artwork") to the highest bidder, as a donation on behalf of Annalù (hereafter referred to as "Artist").

### Information, terms and conditions to participate in the auction:

- **The Artwork must remain on view at the PUNTO SULL'ARTE gallery in Varese** from September 10 to December 3, 2020, period of time that coincides with the possibility to participate in the auction.
- **The minimum bid to participate in the purchase of the Artwork is 20,000.00 euro + VAT**, price that is lower than the actual market estimate.
- **The offer will be considered binding and must be sent in writing** to both of the following e-mail addresses: [donazioni@fibrosicisticaricerca.it](mailto:donazioni@fibrosicisticaricerca.it) - [request@puntosullarte.it](mailto:request@puntosullarte.it)
- If, in the following days, a bid higher than the one received arrives, the potential buyer will be immediately contacted via e-mail and his/her offer will be considered lapsed.
- The person/company that wins the Artwork will be notified on December 4, 2020, and will have to pay the full amount to the Artist with a bank transfer no later than December 8, 2020.
- On the occasion of the 16<sup>th</sup> edition of ArtVerona, the modern and contemporary art fair that will be held at Veronafiere from December 11 to 13<sup>th</sup>, the Buyer and a guest will be invited to the FFC Charity Dinner, scheduled for Sunday, December 13, at the breathtaking Palazzo Giusti (Via Giardino Giusti, 2) in Verona, where the Artwork will be on display. On the occasion, public notice will be given of the Artist's donation of the sale's proceeds to the Fondazione Ricerca Fibrosi Cistica, with official thanks to the Buyer, if interested and available.
- **By participating in the auction, the Buyer confirms that he/she agrees to the delivery of the Artwork in the week following December 13, 2020**, without transport fees, if delivered in Italy.
