# Annalù

*Annalù is an artist with a germinating imagination where nature is declined in liquid forms. From the resin heavily used in her sculptures comes a highly poetic work played on the short circuit between the natural fact and a sumptuous artificiality, between the instant and eternity, between the apparent fragility and the compactness of the material.*


*Her focus is on the moment of passage, of transition between one state and another, through a dynamic equilibrium sharing an attitude very close to the alchemical science aimed at the transmutation of one matter into another.*

*The work recounts an expanded time in which form has the value of a mandala. Annalù's artistic project comes out of all the canons of today's proposal; the oxymoron that underlies her poetics is evident in her work: a sculpture that imposes itself in three dimensions and which seems absolutely, incontrovertibly liquid.*






**DREAMCATCHER LOTUS LIGHT ON**

**DREAMCATCHER RED VISION**








**DREAMCATCHER BREATH DEEPLY**





**LIQUID KILIM**

*I would like to leave the memory of a sculpture that highlights the sensation of a living, pulsating nature and that enhances the sense of immediacy, of transience frozen in an eternal present while at the same time becoming an Absolute form. (Annalù)*





*Annalù composes a mysterious symphony about the balance between two opposites, about the fascination of the oxymoron; that of a powerful, assertive lightness, which leaves no escape and imposes itself on the gaze; that of liquid solidity, which continues to drip for eternity yet never exhausts itself in true movement because it is firm in its immobility; that of a lace that unravels with the perfect rule of a fractal and then reveals itself free and wild like a foaming wave. 



# Biography



**Annalù was born in San Donà di Piave in 1976. In 1999 she graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Venice.**

She regularly exhibits in solo and group exhibitions around the world (United States, Dubai, China, Hong Kong, Greece, France, Germany, Belgium, Slovenia, Switzerland, Portugal, England, Singapore, Russia, Sweden, South Africa).

She presented her work at the Venice Biennale in 2001 and 2011.

She has won numerous awards and mentions. In 2009 she was chosen as the Italian representative at the Moya Museum in Vienna, in 2020 one of her sculptures was acquired by the prestigious German VAF Foundation and in 2024 and 2025 one of her pieces was auctioned at the National Gallery in Singapore.

Throughout her career she has dealt with works of all formats up to site-specific installations of monumental dimensions.

She is an artist with a germinating imagination where nature is expressed in liquid forms. From the resin used in her sculptures comes a highly poetic work played on the short circuit between the natural data and a sumptuous artificiality, between the apparent fragility and the compactness of the material. Her focus is on the moment of transition between one state and another through a dynamic balance sharing an attitude very close to alchemical science aimed at the transmutation of one matter into another.

Her artistic project goes beyond all the canons of today's proposal, making her research absolutely unique. The oxymoron that underlies her poetics is in her work: a sculpture that imposes itself in three dimensions and that seems absolutely, incontrovertibly liquid. She lives and works in Jesolo.
